### Reminders

**CUF Raffle** - Raffle tickets were sent home to all families on Friday, so let the selling begin! ALL tickets sold and unsold - must be returned to your child's classroom teacher in the ticket envelope. If you would like more tickets, simply indicate that on the ticket envelope when returning the money and stubs. When students sell five tickets, their name is entered into a drawing for prizes during Thursday lunch time. The earlier you return sold tickets, the better the chances for prizes! All money raised comes right back to Transfiguration **and** counts toward your fundraising requirement!
