Used Uniform Exchange - Families are invited to come to school on Thursday, July 20th any time between 4-7pm to pick up or exchange used uniform(s) for sizes that better fit your child(ren). If you have gently used uniforms that are too small (current logo only, please), please bring them to school during the week, or the night of the exchange.

Epic Garage Sale - Transfiguration is holding an EPIC garage sale next week, and you are invited! There will be something for everyone, and items can be purchased with a free will donation. All proceeds benefit our school, so come and shop next Thursday-Saturday!

Of course, it will only be EPIC if families help! If you have gently used items, like luggage, tools, sports equipment, books, purses, movies, toys, games, decor, outdoor items, or baby clothing (size 2T or smaller only, please), bring them to school during the drop off times listed above. Unfortunately, we cannot accept furniture, clothing larger than 2T, shoes, or appliances. Thank you!

Sunday Funday Festival - Transfiguration families are invited to our annual Church festival, called Sunday Funday! There will be food, games, music, and more! This festival takes place on August 6, from 12-6pm.

Children's Choir Summer Camp - If your child loves to sing, consider the Transfiguration Children's Choir! Mrs. Van Havermaet, the director, is leading a choir summer camp August 7-11 for all interested students age 7 or older, who have completed first grade. Volunteering and Fundraising

Requirements - Each family is required to volunteer at least 25 hours this year. Not only does this help strengthen the bonds of our community, it helps us to keep tuition costs down. Families are also required



to earn \$250 per child through fundraising (max of \$700 per family). Read below to see how you can get a jump start on both!

Sunday Funday - The parish festival, Sunday Funday, is looking for volunteers to help set up on August 6th, as well as throughout the afternoon. Hours volunteered at this event **do** count toward your family requirement. See this link for more information, and to sign up: <u>Sunday Funday</u>

RaiseRight - Transfiguration participates in RaiseRight, a service that allows families to raise money by purchasing gift cards. Families receive the full amount of the gift card, and RaiseRight sends a percentage of that gift card to Transfiguration as well. That **percentage** counts toward your family fundraising requirement. See the attached flier for more information, and to sign up!

RaiseRight Fundraising

RaiseRight.com or use the RaiseRight App on your phone or mobile device Transfiguration Code: **15984L3758L8**

How it works:

You purchase a gift card from a vendor. You receive the full amount of the gift card, and the vendor sends an additional percentage to Transfiguration. That percentage* accumulates for your fundraising requirement. The larger the percentage, the faster you can meet your goal. *Percentages vary throughout the year; oftentimes vendors will increase the percentage for a limited time, so it's worth checking back often.

For Example:

You purchase \$100 gift card for Cub Foods through RaiseRight. You receive a \$100 Cub Foods giftcard to use on your weekly groceries. You also have earned \$4 (4%) toward your fundraising goal. (Please note, it is the percentage, and not the gift card total, that is raised toward your goal)

How to get started:

Step One: Visit the RaiseRight website, or download the App on your device.

Step Two: Select "Sign Up"

Step Three: Join an existing program by entering Transfiguration's code (above) – this is necessary in order to earn toward your family fundraising requirement

Step Four: Create an account

Step Five: Browse the hundreds of vendors from whom you can purchase a gift card. Some cards can be sent via email or online, while others use a physical card. See the website/app for more details.

Planning ahead really helps you get the most out of this fundraiser! If you know you spend a certain amount at the gas station each week, ordering gift cards ahead of time allows you to use those instead of cash, and earn for our school. This is also great for holiday gifts!
