Curriculum Night - Tomorrow night teachers are excited to speak to parents regarding curriculum and expectations in each grade. Reminders

Lunch Accounts - Please check your child's lunch account on Educate, and add funds when it is low. Some accounts are already showing a negative balance. Money can be added by sending cash/check to the office, or online here.

Fundraising - You can easily raise money towards your school fundraising obligation of \$275 per child by participating in the RaiseRight program (previously knows as Scrip). Since everyone buys groceries, gas, and clothing, this is a win win, and brings back variable percentages of those purchases right to our school. There are 750+ brands to choose from. Plus, you can pick from eGift cards, physical gift cards, and reloading funds digitally onto existing physical gift cards. Gift cards from RaiseRight have no activation fees and they never expire.
