### Walk-A-Thon

**Walk-A-Thon** - Students are Going for the Gold - we are a little over \$2,300 toward our goal. Walk-A-Thon is a major fundraiser that helps to pay for school staff and materials. Online Giving - Great news! The Walk-a-thon now has an online electronic giving option. Go to the Students and Parents webpage and select "Walkathon Electronic donation", or use this link: Walk-A-Thon Then, just choose "one time donation", and under the Fund section, use the drop down to choose "Walk-a-thon". In order for the monies to be associated with your child, in the "Name" section put your name and then the student's name in parentheses. *Anyone* can use this electronic option to donate to the Walk-a-thon (Aunts, Uncles, Grandparents, etc) so spread the word!

## **Volunteering and Fundraising Requirements**

**Volunteering** - Each family has an obligation to do 25 hrs total of volunteering this school year. Most of our volunteer opportunities involve working directly with minors, which requires a Virtus E3 certification through the Archdiocese. Please find our volunteer application form attached, fill this out and return to the school office if you'd like to work with our students.

**RaiseRight** - You will be getting an email invite from RaiseRight (formerly Scrip) this week that you may use to sign up for this fundraising option. If you do not wish to participate, simply ignore the email. RaiseRight allows you to raise money toward your fundraising obligation of \$275 per child without spending extra. Please watch for this email!
